

Dear Circle Dental Patients,

It is with great pleasure and relief that I am now able to announce that Governor Sununu, acting on the unanimous vote of the American Dental Association Advisory Task Force and the approval of the Department of Public Health, has approved the reopening of dental practices in New Hampshire under strict guidelines in place to protect both patients and dental health providers:

- N95 mask have to be worn as well as a face shield;
- Pre-appointment screening process (we are not seeing COVID patients or patients that have been exposed to COVID);
- In-office screening of both patients and dental personnels;
- Hand sanitation station upon entry to our facility to be used by all patients;
- Ultrasonic scaling are prohibited until further notice;
- And many more...

At Circle Dental we believe that those guidelines are effective in protecting both patients and staff and are committed to following those precautions precisely. We have added a few extra of our own. Each of our dental rooms will now be equipped with air filtration. Only of few chairs are in our patient reception area.

We were able to gather the necessary PPE and equipments, we are now fully reopening to serve our community. As you can expect from us, we have done this correctly and are thankful that you have entrusted us with your care for many years.

We will be contacting you shortly in chronological order as well as priority. It appears that the COVID situation is not a temporary one and will last for the foreseeable future. As a community we have to adapt to the new normal with appropriate measures. Our society has to remain operational and I cannot emphasize enough how vital for our health and immune resistance it is to stay current with dental care.

We have done our part in reopening the office to normal dental care and to be there for our patients. We are now inviting you to join us to get back on track with your oral health.
